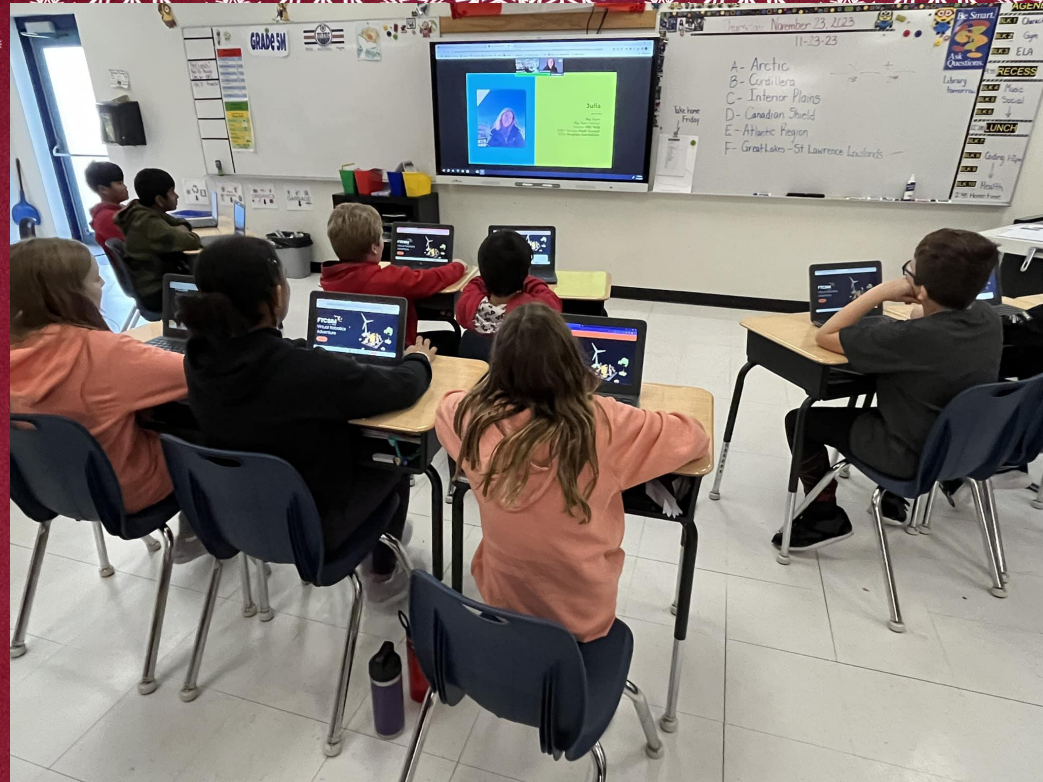
Big congratulations to École Champs Vallée School Junior Boys Volleyball team who took home the gold medal on Nov. 21!



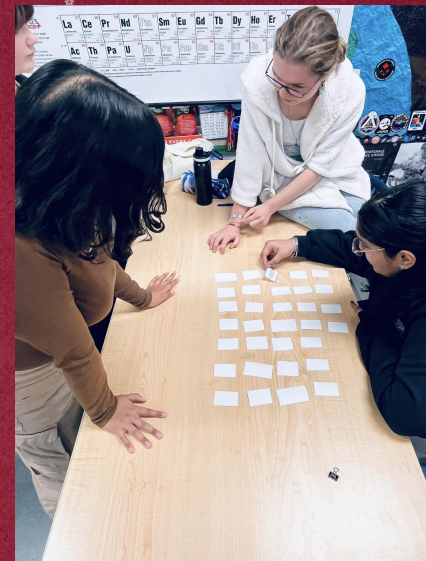
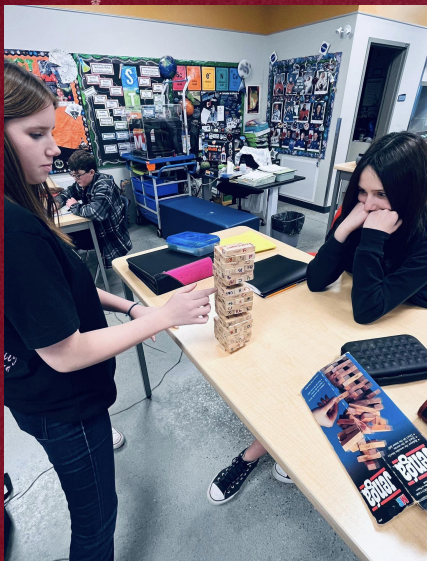
Congratulations to the New Sarepta Community High School Junior High girls volleyball championship team!
