
The grades 5 and 6 students at École Coloniale Estates School are learning to crochet!

Congratulations to the Leduc Composite High School Junior Girls Basketball team for winning the Metro Athletics championship!




École J. E. Lapointe School's first-ever Robotics team, the CyberSabres, had a wonderful time at the First Lego League Northern Alberta Qualifiers.
