Black Gold School Division is seeking a **Curriculum Lead Teacher (Gr. 1-6)** with a strong background in Gr 1-6 literacy and numeracy to join our team. The successful candidate will be a key member of a collaborative team and will work closely with the Grade 1-6 Instructional Support Teachers (ISTs) exploring strategies to identify and remediate gaps in student literacy and numeracy learning.

#### **The Curriculum Lead Teacher (Literacy) will:**

- Coordinate the distribution, administration, and data collection of literacy and numeracy screening tools and provide leadership in analyzing the data.
- Engage in action research on improving student literacy and numeracy and build a deeper understanding of how the data can be used to inform practice at the classroom, school and Division level.
- Lead BGSD collaborative learning communities for Gr 1-6 literacy and numeracy.
- Curate evidence-based strategies to enhance instructional and assessment practices for literacy and numeracy and work with school based ISTs to identify and share effective instructional practices.
- Build capacity in understanding literacy and numeracy and how to apply promising practices across grade levels and content areas.
- Work collaboratively with groups/teams working on Black Gold initiatives.
- Support teachers with effective and appropriate use of technology to support literacy and numeracy.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Minimum of 5 years of successful teaching practice in more than one classroom context.
- Experience using a wide variety of research-based literacy strategies in classrooms.
- Expertise with literacy numeracy in Alberta Curriculum.
- Strong interpersonal communication skills and ability to build strong collegial relationships.

- Innovative approaches to problem solving.
