The Division extends from the New Sarepta area to the east, to the Warburg area to the west. It includes the municipalities of Beaumont, Devon, Thorsby, Calmar, City of Leduc and Leduc County. The Board of Trustees consists of seven trustees; one from Ward 1 (Warburg & Thorsby), one from Ward 2 (Devon & Calmar), three from Ward 3 (City of Leduc) and two from Ward 4 (Beaumont & New Sarepta). The Division Office is located in Nisku east of the Edmonton International Airport. Our jurisdiction borders the south boundary of the city of Edmonton.
