Currently there are not enough classrooms in the school for the K-8 configuration and a classroom was created in the library. The current grade 6 enrolment of the feeder school will require additional grade 7 classrooms for 2017-18. As well, there is significant development in the neighborhoods surrounding the school as the City of Leduc expands into recently annexed land. The enrolment growth was 6.3% in Leduc in 2016-17.

The enrolment growth was 7.1% in Devon in 2016-17. Additional washrooms are required and will be designed into the link construction.
