# BLACK GOLD AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP

## **About the Scholarship:**

The scholarship is funded by donations from Cory Bablitz, graduate of Calmar Secondary School.

### **Amount to be Awarded:**

A \$500 scholarship will be awarded annually to a graduate of a Black Gold Regional Division No. 18 high school who is continuing with studies at the post-secondary level.

## **Eligibility and Criteria for Applications:**

- a) The student must have been enrolled in a Black Gold Regional school for their grade twelve year and completed their high school program in three years;
- b) The student must be accepted into a post-secondary program; and
- c) The student must demonstrate a genuine commitment to academics, sports (community or school), and citizenship/volunteer opportunities.

## **Application Procedures:**

Eligible students submit an application to the principal by September 10<sup>th</sup> following their graduation. The application must include:

- a) a covering letter,
- b) a summary of their academic achievement, sports achievement, and citizenship/volunteer contribution, and
- c) three letters of reference (one for each of academic, sports, and citizenship/volunteer).

## **Selection Process and Presentation of the Scholarship:**

Principals submit their school's candidate to the Superintendent/designate by September 15<sup>th</sup>. A selection committee consisting of the Superintendent/designate and two high school principals will select the successful scholarship applicant by September 20<sup>th</sup> and the award will be presented at the recipient's school award ceremony.
