


SCHOOL NEWS

New Sarepta Elementary School's Grade 5/6 Boys Floor Hockey team captured gold at the Black Gold Tournament at École Corinthia Park School.




At a band fundraiser at New Sarepta Community High School, Board Chair Eckert bid and won the opportunity to conduct the senior band's last song that evening.
