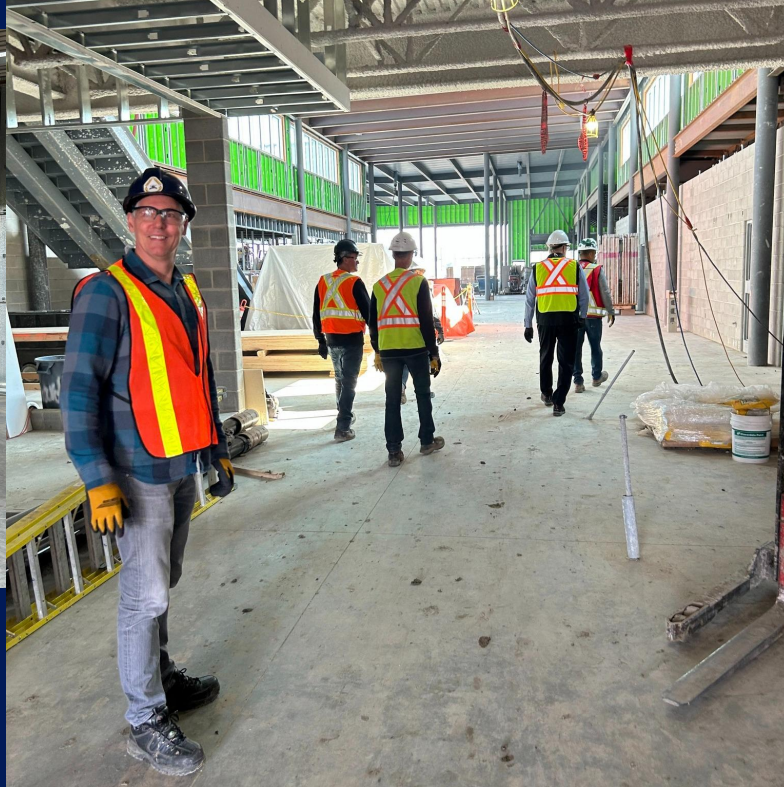
The École J. E. Lapointe School held a Grade 9 retreat and team builder on September 6. A beautiful day for Dragon Boat races and beach volleyball.

New Sarepta Community High School Senior Boys Volleyball Team got a First Place finish at the Lamont Tournament September 9 - congratulations!



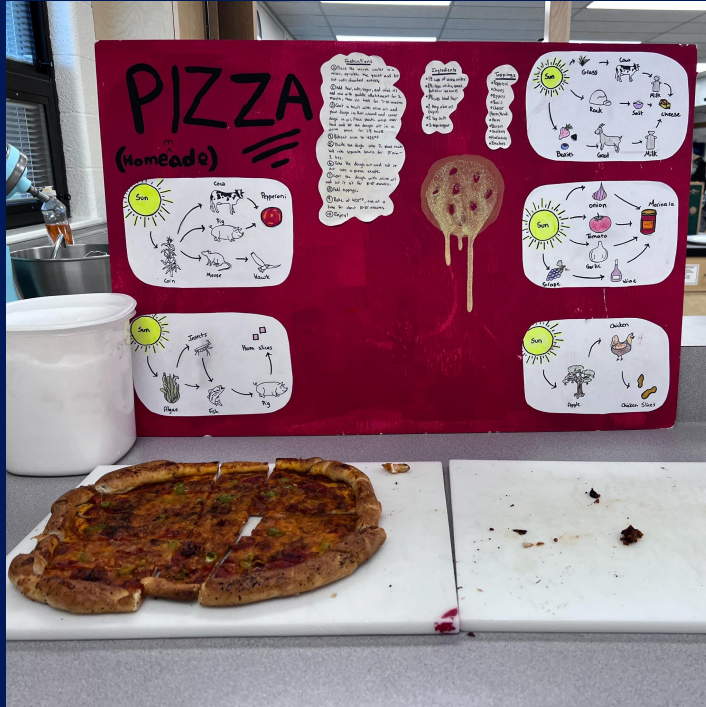

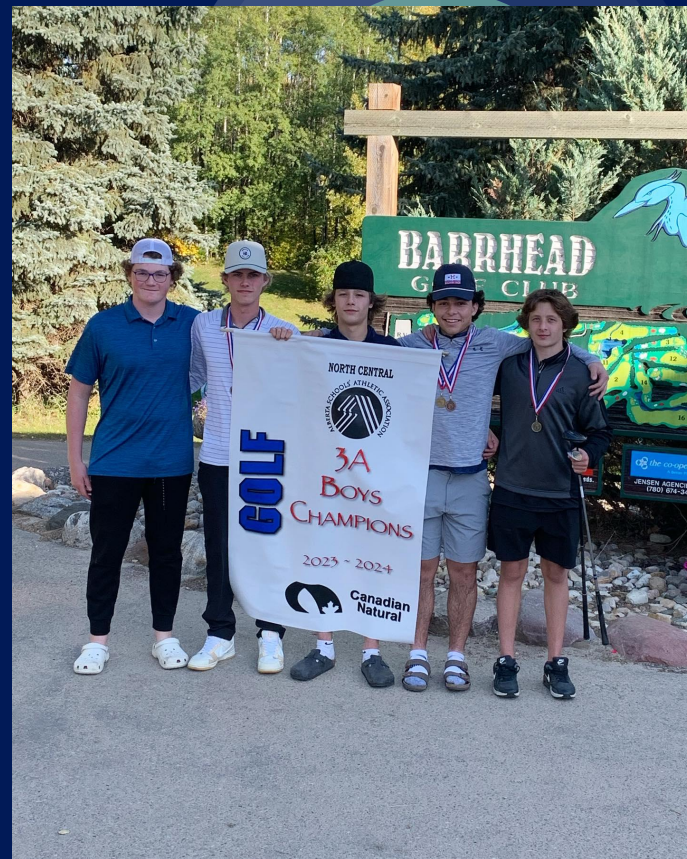
Congratulations to the senior girls volleyball team at John Maland High School for winning gold at their tournament on September 19. Well done!
